



**SAFELINK WIRELESS® is a program that offers no contract, no cost cell phones and service to eligible households.** To participate in the SAFELINK WIRELESS® service, certain eligibility requirements must be met, which are set by each state where the service is provided. In general, to qualify subscribers must either have an income that is at or below 135% of the federal poverty guidelines, or participate in one of the following assistance programs:

- Medicaid
- Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) food stamps
- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
- Federal public housing assistance (Section 8)
- Veterans and Survivors Pension Benefit
