

## Essential Supplies Program (ESP)

### Description:

Urban Alliance collaborates with World Vision to offer a variety of top-quality donated items, including new clothing, personal hygiene items, household items and cleaning products, and furniture to programs that are partnering with Urban Alliance through one of its initiatives. On a monthly basis, participating programs shop at World Vision's ESP for free supplies to use as they help to meet the basic needs of the children and adults they serve.

To participate in the Essential Supplies Program, programs must identify a representative to attend a 60-minute World Vision's orientation and complete a registration process. During the orientation, program leaders will learn how to effectively engage with the ESP and how to best utilize this resource. Program leaders will receive

an invitation via email to attend an upcoming Essential Supplies Program orientation. After completing the 60-minute orientation and registration process, the designated shopper will be responsible for scheduling the program's shopping date and time on a monthly basis via World Vision's online scheduling system.

**Capacity:** Capacity is the degree to which programs have the mechanisms in place to effectively operate. This PDO increases a programs capacity by providing needed programming supplies which can be distributed to people served or off-set other programming costs.

### Eligibility

Your program must be operated by a church or organization in the Urban Alliance network, have completed a Program Commitment Form and be in good standing (i.e., participate in a learning community, submit monthly data and follow the program development opportunity policies), provide regularly scheduled ongoing programming. Programs needs to serve people at least monthly to be eligible.
