

Ages and Stages Developmental Screening Questionnaire: ASQ-3 and ASQ:SE-2 Toolkit

Toolkit Description:

The Ages and Stages developmental screening questionnaires offer caregivers of young children an easy way to screen for developmental delays in infants and young children. The Ages and Stages Questionnaire, Third Edition (ASQ-3) detects delays across five areas of development (physical motor, fine motor, communication, intellectual, or social- emotional). It is **strongly recommended** that staff and volunteers be trained and utilize this screening tool before using the ASQ:SE-2.

The Ages and Stages Social Emotional ASQ: SE-2 can be used to detect social and emotional delays or concerns. This tool is designed to provide caregivers critical knowledge about their child's development to determine if further evaluation is needed and early intervention services are required.

Connection: Connection occurs when a program links people to resources in the community. This PDO equips early childhood programs to more effectively connect families to needed services so young children with developmental delays receive support and early intervention more quickly. Early intervention is linked to improved child outcomes.


ASQ Training:

Urban Alliance helps to train and equip program leaders to administer and score Ages and Stages screening questionnaires for children from birth to five years. Additionally, this training will equip program leaders to learn how to effectively share results with parents and caregivers, and provide information about activities that will promote healthy child development. This training is required for program leaders receiving this toolkit for the first time.
